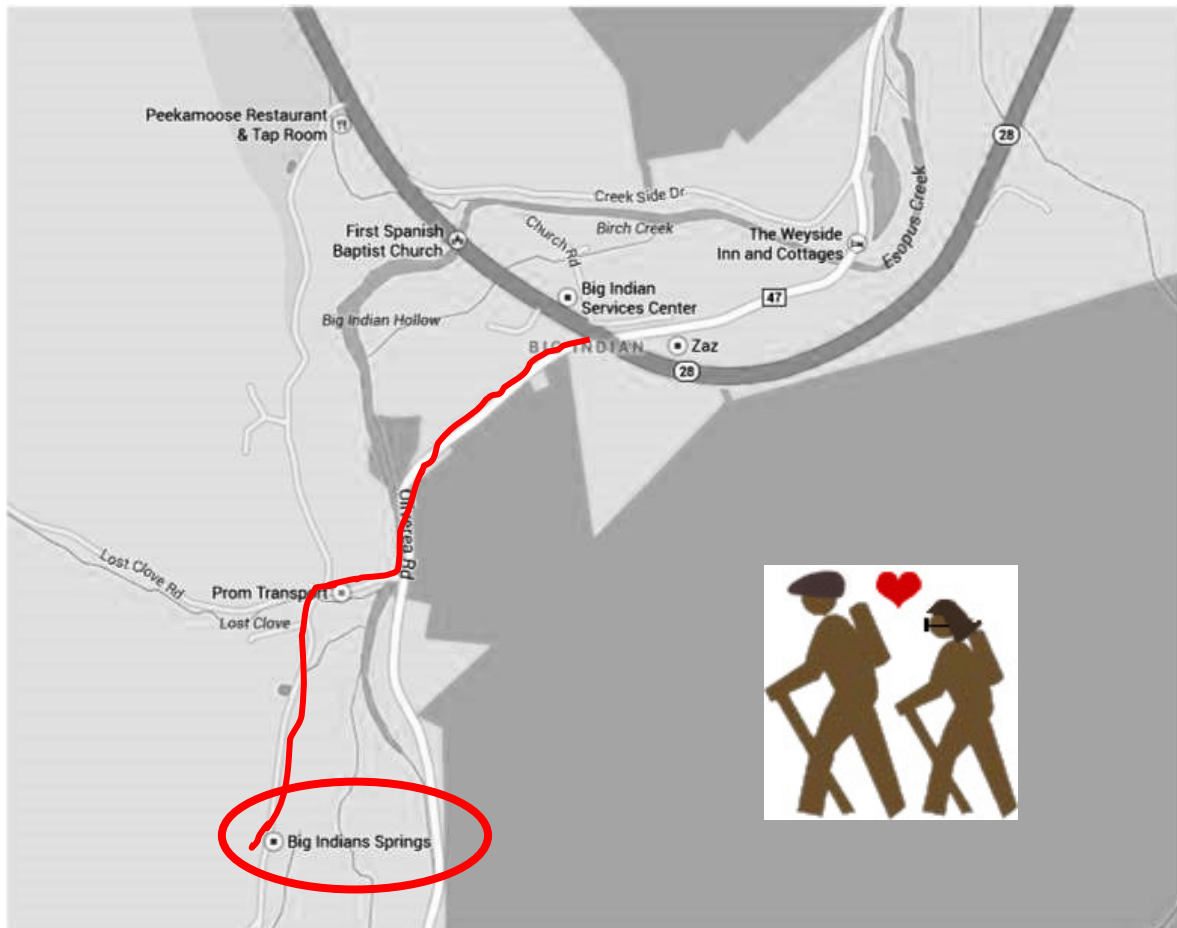


BRETT & MARGARET'S WEDDING: The Details

Directions

- NY State Thruway (87) to Exit 19 – Kingston/NY Route 28
- Follow Route 28 WEST for 30 miles, through Boyceville, Phoenicia, Shandaken, and into Big Indian.
- Turn LEFT on Oliverea Road (47) at the four-way intersection.
- After ½ mile, make first RIGHT to cross the bridge over the creek (Lost Cove Road).
- Make the first LEFT onto Cruickshank Road.
- When you get to the green Dumpster and sign, you've arrived! Pull up to the right to drop stuff off, or turn left to park (see info below).



Parking

When you get to the green Dumpster and Sign, turn left to park, or bear right up the driveway to drop stuff off.

- No parking in the house driveway (sorry!).
- Instead, from Cruickshank Road, turn left after the Dumpster.
- The driveway is narrow and curves to the left.
- Keep going until you get to a HUGE open field.
- Please don't park anywhere else.
- After dark, a string of lights will help you find the way.

Schedule

FRIDAY 5/16

- 9-12: Breakfast and Goodbyes (and house reset)

Phone service

There is mostly no cell phone service in Big Indian. The landline for the house is 845-254-5505. Incoming calls are free. (There's no wifi either, sorry!)

Other House Information

- **Bathrooms:** There are 8 bathrooms total:
 - Three on the second floor – turn left at the top of the stairs.
 - Two on the third floor – ditto
 - One at the end of the second floor hallway (Sandy/Brian/Kim's suite)
 - One at the end of the third floor hallway (Brett/Margaret/Betsy's suite)
 - There is also a bathroom on the main floor, in the kitchen. (Please don't use that one while the caterers are in action.)
- **Garbage:** Because of BEARS(!), we'll keep all garbage in the kitchen. The caterers are dealing with the reception garbage. House guests should bring their garbage down before leaving on Sunday morning. Then we'll lock it in the Dumpster, because apparently bears can open things. No bear baiting or wrestling allowed.
- **Kitchen & Food:** The kitchen at the house has two fridges, a microwave, two coffee makers, an electric tea kettle, a toaster, and a huge oven. Shama Davis will be cooking breakfast and nibbles on Saturday (thank you, Shama!). Sunday's breakfast will be from Bread Alone. Feel free to leave your snacks and bevs in the kitchen – mark anything you don't want to share.
- **Property Line:** The house property includes the pond, the tennis/volleyball courts, the parking lot/field, and the pool area behind the house. NOTE: Cruikshank Road becomes a private drive past the pond. Trespassers will be fed to the bears or locked in the Dumpster.

Grocery Shopping

- Morra's Market – at the intersection of Routes 47 and 28 (very close).
- Belleayre Plaza Shopping Center – a few miles East (RIGHT) on Route 28.
- Boiceville IGA – 15 miles East (RIGHT) on Route 28
- Margaretville SuperFresh – 15 miles West (LEFT) on Route 28 (turn into Margaretville and you will see it).

Cool Stuff To Do

Nearby Towns:

Kingston (West Side of the Hudson) – check out the historic Stockade District, or the Rondout area down by the river!

Woodstock (West Side) – Hello, Hippies! See how a whole generation sold out.

Rhinebeck (East Side) – Swanky shops, restaurants, and indie movie theater.

Art:

Opus 40 (East Side) – A sculptor’s amazing landscape project. Open 11-5:30 Thu–Sun.

Storm King (West Side) – Sculpture garden against the backdrop of Bear Mountain. Open 10-5:30 Weds-Sun.

Dia: Beacon (East Side) – Contemporary art in a huge former Nabisco packaging factory. Open 11-4pm Fri–Mon.

Nature:

Ashokan Reservoir Dam (West Side) – Hiking. Pretty dam cool. (Take 28A from Boiceville.)

Walkway Across the Hudson (Either) – A foot/bike bridge that links Poughkeepsie and Highland.

Slide Mountain Trail (West Side) – The highest peak in the Catskills. Keep going on Route 47.

History:

Hyde Park (East Side) – the home (and archive!) of Franklin Delano Roosevelt. Open 9-5 every day.

West Point (West Side) – for Constitution Island, go to Cold Spring (East Side) for the ferry.

D&H Canal Museum (West Side)–hike the Five Locks Walk. Sunday market 9-4.
